



Electronics Recycling

Electronic products constitute one of the fastest growing streams of today's consumer and commercial waste. In November 2010, the Pennsylvania General Assembly passed the Covered Device Recycling Act (CDRA), which establishes a number of requirements for individuals and entities involved throughout the life cycle of certain "covered" electronic devices. Covered devices include: desktop computers, laptop computers, computer monitors, computer peripherals and televisions.

Electronic devices will be prohibited from landfill disposal at the Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority (GLRA) effective January 1, 2012. For this reason we are unable to accept electronic devices as trash and residents and businesses in Lebanon County are prohibited from placing such items in with their trash for disposal. Electronic devices must be taken to a DEP approved Covered Device Recycling Facility.

GLRA will open a facility to recycle private household electronic devices which is approved under CDRA on or about January 2, 2012. There will be no charge for residents to drop off their electronic devices at the GLRA facility. If you are unable to take your devices to the GLRA facility we will pickup and deliver them for you. There is an extra charge for this service.
